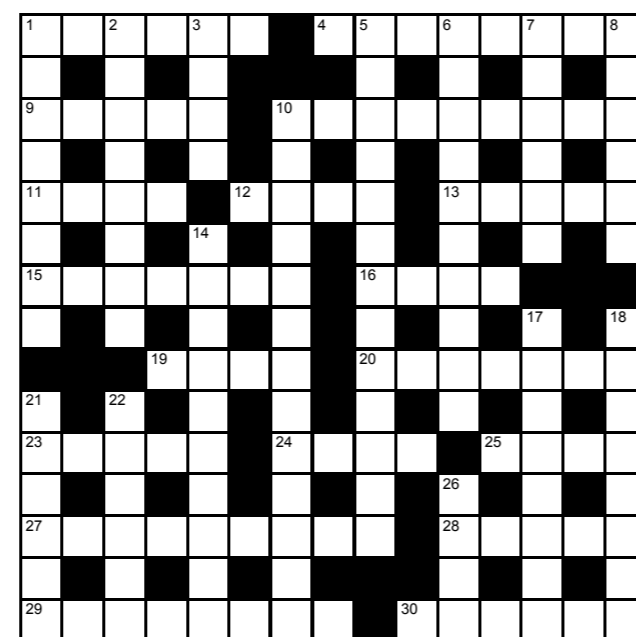
ALTERNATIVE LIDO DINING

PASSING CAPE TRAFALGAR EN ROUTE TO THE BARCELONA

FROM THE NAVIGATOR



Throughout the night and early morning QUEEN ELIZABETH maintained southerly courses, paralleling the Portuguese coast before rounding Cape Roca, the westernmost point on the Iberian Peninsula. From here

we will head towards Cape St Vincent, which we will reach this afternoon, before setting a southwesterly course towards the Strait of Gibraltar. This evening we will pass south of Cape Trafalgar where on 21 October 1805, the British Fleet led by Admiral Lord Horatio Nelson aboard HMS Victory, defeated a much larger Franco-Spanish Fleet without a single British vessel being lost. The Franco-Spanish lost 22 ships.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

BEAUFORT SCALE

The Beaufort scale is an empirical measure for describing wind intensity based mainly on observed sea conditions. Its full name is the Beaufort wind force scale. The scale was created in 1805 by Irishman Sir Francis Beaufort, a British naval officer and hydrographer. At that time naval officers made regular weather observations, but there was no scale and so they could be very subjective - one man's "stiff breeze" might be another's "calm conditions".
