



A wonderful opportunity to discover Adelaide and head to Australia's vibrant capital city, Canberra.

DAY 1 – ADELAIDE

Enjoy the day exploring Adelaide before an evening flight to Canberra. You'll begin by heading to the **Cleland Wildlife Park**, where you can see cuddly koalas and hand-feed the **kangaroos**. This natural bush setting is also home to wombats, dingoes, emus and colourful bird life. Afterwards, you'll continue to **Hahndorf**, the oldest surviving German settlement in Australia and a town steeped in history. Delight in the leisurely, old-world feel of this town as you take in the many craft shops, and boutiques. A local style lunch will be served. During the day, **luncheon**, accompanied by a tea or coffee will be served in a local restaurant.

In the late afternoon, you'll head to the airport for your early evening flight across to Canberra. Upon arrival, you'll transfer to the Crowne Plaza Hotel and after check-in; relax in the comfort of your hotel room for the evening.

DAY 2 – CANBERRA

Following breakfast, you'll spend the day city sightseeing and taking in the best of Canberra both old and new. Enjoy a guided tour of the **Parliament House** and gain an insight into the history of Australian democracy, before heading to the **Regatta Point**, a picturesque café that overlooks the manmade Lake Burley Griffin. Here, you can relax with a tea or coffee and admire the view. Next, you'll visit the **National Museum of Australia**, where a guided tour will show the rich and diverse collection of historical exhibits and rare indigenous artefacts.

Luncheon, accompanied by a glass or wine or beer, will be served in the casual surroundings of the museum café, most notable for its lovely views across the lake. Following lunch, and a panoramic drive around the lake and surrounds, your day will round off with a guided tour of the **War Memorial**, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and The Hall of Valour. You'll also visit the **Anzac Hall** that brings exhibits to life with a sound and light show and concludes with a poignant closing ceremony.

Back at the hotel, you'll have the chance to freshen up, before heading out for **dinner** at one of Canberra's award-winning restaurants, to savour a delicious four-course meal.

DAY 3 – CANBERRA - MELBOURNE

After breakfast and check-out, you'll continue your city sightseeing and make your way to the **Mount Ainslie Lookout**. Here, you can enjoy a photograph stop and admire the views that stretch across the city. You'll then drive through the **National Arboretum**, a 250 hectare site that surrounds visitors with undulating countryside landscape, and on to the **Telstra Tower**. Built in 1980s, the 195 metre tower is one of the city's most iconic sites and offers 360 degree views from its viewing platforms. Free time will be given for you to explore the tower and purchase luncheon or refreshments at the onsite café. Afterwards, bid farewell to Canberra, as you are transferred to the airport for your early evening flight to Melbourne to re-join Queen Mary.

Note: Bookings for this tour will close on 15th December 2017. Any bookings made after this time will be on a request basis only. There is a strict minimum and maximum participation. Please ensure you book the correct tour code for the accommodation you require (double = ADL802, single = ADL803). Prices shown on your record of shore excursions are per person. Once your booking is confirmed, any cancellation made after bookings close will incur a 100% cancellation fee. This tour departs Adelaide 16th February and returns into Melbourne 18th February. Please check your embarkation/disembarkation dates carefully before booking this overland. This excursion involves early morning starts and lengthy days. No refunds will be given for any unused portion. Flight times and further details will be advised on board, hotels are subject to change.

The fare includes: transport by coach and plane, services of a guide, sightseeing, refreshments and meals, hotel accommodation as stated above. Meals include water, tea and standard coffee. Wine pairing is offered with the evening meal on day two. Any additional beverages will be charged to guests' own account. A light seasonal dinner will be served on the outbound flight and

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The fare does not include: items of a personal nature such as phone calls, laundry, gratuities, room service, additional refreshments, doctor's fees and any medication or prescriptions. **Visas are required and are not included.** As this overland tour involves leaving the ship and re-joining in another port, your visa requirements may vary dependent on your nationality and the duration of your stay. It is your responsibility to ensure you are in receipt of the correct documentation and we recommend you check on the applicable government website for visa and entry requirements. Luncheon is not included on day three to allow guests to make the most of their last day in Canberra. Due to the logistics of the itinerary please note that sightseeing in Melbourne is not possible.

What to pack: Please remember your passport and any medication you may require. It is advisable to pack lightly; luggage limit is one bag per person with a maximum weight of 20kg. Valuables should be left on board the ship. Please remember to carry a credit card or Australian dollars for any additional purchases.
