NAVIGATION INFORMATION

Throughout the night Queen Mary 2 headed northerly across the Caribbean sea towards the island of Saint Kitts. We make our northerly approach to the island and we expect to board our pilot at 7.00am. With the pilot onboard we approach Basseterre, Saint Kitts' capital city. The city lies within the large Basseterre Valley, almost completely surrounded by lush green hills and mountains. It is primarily low-lying, which explains the name the French gave unto it, as Basseterre translates to "low land" in English. Basseterre's main exports are rum, beer, foodstuffs and electronics. The once dominating sugar industry closed in 2005.

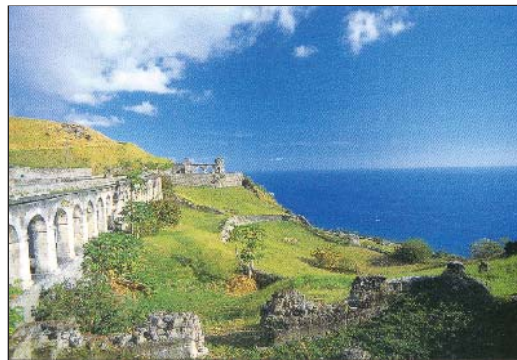

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

A nautical mile is the unit of distance used at sea and it is considerably different from the standard mile of 1760 yards used on shore. A nautical mile is the distance on the earth's surface subtended by one minute of latitude at the earth's centre. If the earth were a perfect sphere, one nautical mile would be equivalent to an arc length of one minute at all places and in all directions. Because of the earth's oblate spheroid shape, the length of the nautical mile varies slightly with the latitude, being shorter at equator and longest at the poles. The length of a standard nautical mile is 6080 feet (or 1852 metres, or 1.15 statute miles).

Welcome to Basseterre, St. Kitts



St. Kitts has become a resort mecca in recent years. Its major crop is sugar, a tradition dating from the 17th century. But tourism may overwhelm it in the years to come, as its southeastern peninsula, site of the best white-sand beaches, has been set aside for massive resort development. Most of the island's other beaches are of gray or black volcanic sand.

The Caribs, the early settlers, called the island Liamuiga, or "fertile isle." Its mountain ranges reach up to nearly 1,200m (3,936 ft.), and its interior contains virgin rainforests, alive with hummingbirds and wild green vervet monkeys. The monkeys were brought in as pets by the early French settlers but were set free when the British took control of the island in 1783. These native African animals have proliferated and can be seen at the Estridge Estate Behavioral Research Institute.

Did you Know...

The Cunard Funnels

Cunard Red, the distinctive colour of the Cunard funnels, has an interesting history. In the 1830s, Robert Napier, a British shipping engineer who improved and developed steamships that would be the first of the Cunard line, was faced with a dilemma. The heat in the smokestacks reached such high temperatures that conventional paints of the day would bubble and peel off. The painters developed a clever solution. A mixture of bright ochre and buttermilk was applied. With the heat of the smokestacks, the paint mixture literally "cooked" onto the stacks and stayed put. The resulting orange/red colour, accented with a broad black band at the top of each stack and black lines on the flanges, was to become Napier's trademark and, later, the identifying mark of all Cunard liners. The tradition remained, even though paint manufacturers had discovered a way to delete the buttermilk from the formula.
