Please be reminded that early on Monday morning the ship's time was **ADVANCED ONE HOUR**. This will be repeated tomorrow and clocks will be **ADVANCED ONE HOUR** early on Tuesday morning. Please advance your watches before retiring for the evening.

NAVIGATION INFORMATION

During the morning we will pass over the Faraday Fracture Zone, part of the undersea volcanic range known as the Mid Atlantic Ridge. Depths over the ridge shallow to around 700 meters before dropping off again to over 4,000 meters. As we continue on a east-northeasterly Great Circle track to Bishop Rock, we will be at the same approximate latitude as Newfoundland and Brittany, France.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

The compass is the instrument by which a ship may be steered on a pre-selected course and by which bearings of visible objects may be taken to fix a ship's position on a chart. There are two types of compasses in use at sea: the magnetic compass, of which the north mark points to the magnetic North Pole, and the gyroscopic (or gyro) compass, of which the north mark points to the true North Pole. At the heart of a marine gyrocompass assembly there is a perfectly balanced wheel (gyroscope rotor) which is arranged to spin symmetrically at high speed about an axis; a gyroscope rotor maintains the direction of its plane of rotation unless an external force of sufficient amplitude is applied to overcome this inertia.
