

### HODMEDOD'S

Hodmedod's is a small, but expanding, independent business that was founded in 2012. The company works with British farmers to provide pulses and grains, from fair and sustainable UK produced sources, utilising organic elements whenever possible.

### BERMONDSEY STREET BEES

Dale Gibson, one of Britain's best-known professional beekeepers, founded the sustainable beekeeping practice, Bermondsey Street Bees in 2007. Dale advocates ecology-based approaches to keeping urban and country bees, and is an artisan producer who adheres to traditional production techniques. Their multi-award-winning raw honeys are sustainably produced, and made by bees living on wild, rewilded, and regenerative land.



# THE BOOK & BUCKET CHEESE COMPANY

Mutli-World Cheese Award Winners, The Book and Bucket Cheese Company was founded by Peter Morgan. When Peter began making cheese, he sought counsel from a group of people that possessed over 120 years of industry experience between them. Their best advice for a starting point, was to buy and read as many books as possible. After that, they agreed it was just 'bucket science', and advised Peter to keep playing until he made something he liked – and that he thought someone would buy. #### UNION COFFEE

Founded in 2001 by Jeremy Torz and Steven Macatonia, Union Coffee develops small batches of 100% arabica coffee, with beans sourced from smallholder farmers in Asia, Africa, and Latin America. Indulgent notes of dark chocolate and sweet treacle, balanced by red apple-like acidity, characterise their signature Campañero blend: unmistakable, wherever it is drunk around the world.



### CHALKSTREAM

Founder and entrepreneur, Hugo Hardman, began a trout revival in 2014 with the formation of ChalkStream. He recognised the uniqueness of fine English trout raised in farms fed by the world-famous Test and Itchen Rivers in Hampshire, and how underappreciated they were by the market. ChalkStream trout are slow grown for two years, in farms built on fast-flowing pure chalk stream water, resulting in fish that are fit and lean with a unique, clean taste.
