Guide to completing the Belgium Passenger Locator Form (PLF).

Every guest travelling to Belgium, whether planning to stay on board or explore ashore, must complete the PLF.



Complete the Belgium PLF
before embarking your ship.

Who needs to complete a Passenger Locator Form (PLF)?

- ◆ Every adult guest travelling to Belgium, whether planning to stay on board or explore ashore.
- ◆ Any children under 12 that are travelling will need to be added on to one adult's form.
- ◆ Children aged 12-17 need to complete their own PLF.

When must I complete the PLF?

You must complete the Belgium Passenger Locator Form prior to sailing and have a copy of this document for embarkation.

How do I access the form?

You can access the form here at <https://travel.info-coronavirus.be/public-health-passenger-locator-form> from any internet-enabled device. You will need to register some personal details.

What information do I need to provide?

- ◆ **Passport information** – including passport number or your travel document information you'll use.
- ◆ **Contact details** – email address and phone number.
- ◆ **Travel details** – including voyage number and the ports you will visit.
- ◆ **Residential address** – the port address for the ship, which is as follows:

- A vaccination certificate proves that you have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19. You are fully vaccinated 2 weeks after your last vaccination dose and if the vaccine is EMA-certified.
- A recovery certificate shows that you have recovered from COVID-19. You have a positive PCR test result no older than 180 days and you no longer need to quarantine.
- A test certificate is proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test result.
