In 2021, Queen Victoria sets off from London on a complete westbound circumnavigation of the globe. A Transatlantic Crossing takes her to the Panama Canal, then she sails across the Pacific to Australia, through Southeast Asia and around Africa's Cape of Good Hope. 


Fresh from a refit in 2018, her elegant wood paneling, gleaming chandeliers, and marble flooring evoke the heyday of Hollywood glamour.






Queen Victoria is a grand ship in terms of size and décor, and has a particularly warm and intimate feeling throughout.




