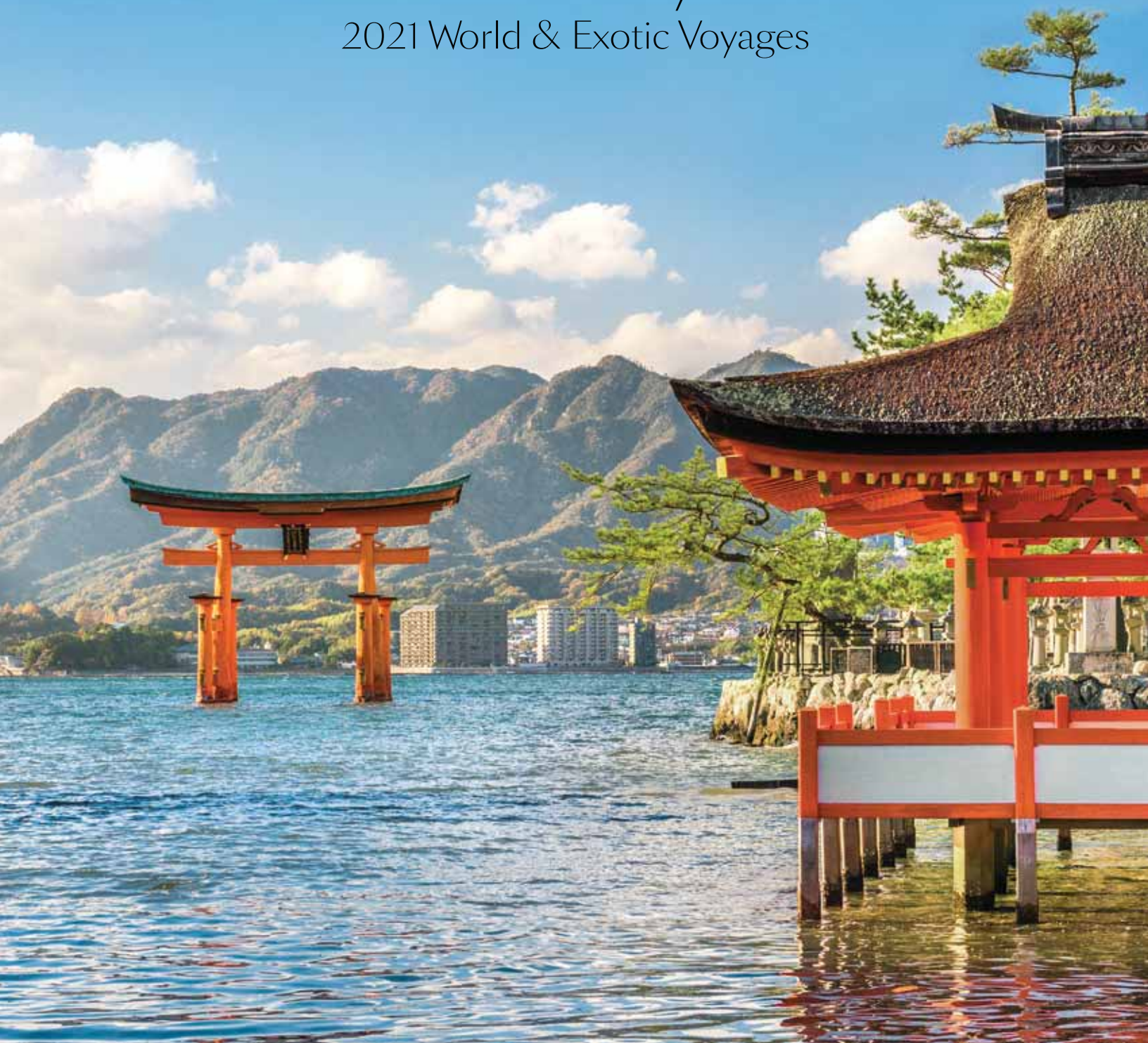

In 2021, Queen Victoria sets off from London on a complete westbound circumnavigation of the globe. A Transatlantic Crossing takes her to the Panama Canal, then she sails across the Pacific to Australia, through Southeast Asia and around Africa's Cape of Good Hope. In total, Queen Victoria visits 33 ports in 22 countries, providing you with access to 21 UNESCO World Heritage Sites and overnights in San Francisco, Honolulu, Sydney, Hong Kong, Singapore and Cape Town.
