## Sparkling Wine.

### 601 Prosecco Superiore Prestige 1821, Zonin, Valdobbiadene DOCG, Italy (2)

Valdobbiadene DOCG represent the elite of all Prosecco made in Veneto. Beautiful aromas of acacia flower & white orchard fruit. On the palate elements of white peach, yellow apple and ripe pear alongside bright acidity.

## White Wines.

### 602 Gavi di Gavi La Minaia, Nicola Bergaglio, Italy (1)

Thin-skinned Cortese, the white grape that makes Piedmont's Gavi, releases aromas of acacia and white peach, flicks the nose with wild herb, then settles on the tongue in a swirl of apple, lemon and melon.

### 603 Chardonnay Block 1A, The Lane, Adelaide Hills, Australia (2)

Block 1A is a blend of parcels of premium quality Chardonnay from across the Lane; designed to showcase the hallmark elegance, balance and structural precision common to all wines from this exciting boutique estate.

### 604 Sauvignon Blanc Single Vineyard "Garuma", Viña Leyda, Chile (2)

Sauvignon Blanc grapes from the estate's coolest vineyard, just 12km from the Pacific Ocean, which brings a gentle breeze of lime and grapefruit, tempered by green chilli peppers, more grapefruit and a little gooseberry in the mouth.

### 605 Pinot Grigio, La Tunella, Colli Orientali del Friuli, Italy (2)

An intense, fresh bouquet of acacia blossom and ripe tropical fruit, with subtle brioche notes and flavours of peaches and cream on the palate. This wine is elegant and full-bodied with rare length - not your average Pinot Grigio!

### 606 Riesling Kung Fu Girl, Charles Smith, Washington State, USA (4)

With fruit from a single vineyard in Ancient Lakes, this shows Riesling's fun and funky side. Supremely smooth and beautifully aromatic with flavours of apricot, lime and nectarine. This is a big bold white, medium-bodied, with a long, crisp finish.

### 607 Sauvignon Blanc, Framingham, Marlborough, New Zealand (2)

A rainbow of flavours from tangy grapefruit and bitter lemon, to redcurrant and tropical fruits. Well rounded mouthfeel with good weight, elegant acidity and a hint of creaminess.

### 608 Sancerre Le Petit Broux Rosé, Les Celliers de Cérès, Centre Loire, France (2)

Sancerre Rosé Petit Broux Cave de Sancerre wine appeals to all lovers of Provence Rosé who also like brighter, fresher styles. Sancerre Rosé Petit Broux is a glowing pink rose, fragrant and appetising, with delicious aromas of wild strawberry, peach and redcurrant. Light coloured in the Provence style, but with brighter strawberry fruit; from the noble Pinot Noir variety.

## Red Wines.

- 609 Malbec Aruma, Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite) and Nicolás Catena, Mendoza, Argentina (C)**  
Argentine Malbec tends to be velvet smooth and deeply fruity with violet spice, but barrel aged Aruma has even more to offer. This award winning red combines the expertise of Bordeaux's Barons de Rothschild (Lafite) and world renowned Nicolás Catena.
- 610 Pinot Noir Are you Game, Fowles Wine, Australia (B)**  
Pinot Noir with a leavening dash of Mourvèdre from Victoria, south-east Australia, delivering baskets of cherry and strawberry to the mouth, complemented by bracken, fresh earth and a touch of oak on the nose.
- 611 Valpolicella Classico Superiore, Terra di Cariano, Cecilia Beretta, Veneto, Italy (D)**  
Intense aromas of blackcurrant, bitter almonds and warm spice. Full, ripe and round on the palate, with impressive structure a long, chocolaty finish.
- 612 Reflets du Château Cissac, Bordeaux, France (D)**  
The second wine from Château Cissac is a modern Bordeaux with ripe tannins, intense dark fruit and pleasant oaky flavours.

- 613 Shiraz The Footbolt, d'Arenberg, McLaren Vale, Australia (D)**  
Earthy, spicy Shiraz from McLaren Vale in South Australia, full of black plums, liquorice and black pepper, with a peaty underlayer of mushroom, pipe tobacco and charcuterie.
- 614 Merlot Velvet Devil, Charles Smith, Washington State, United States of America (D)**  
Named the 'Velvet Devil' due to this wine's soft, smooth velvety texture. Classic Merlot aromas of dark cherries, cedar, pipe tobacco. Medium-bodied but very ripe, with bright acidity and a long, spicy finish.
- 615 Old Vine Zinfandel, Maggio Family Vineyards, Lodi, United States of America (D)**  
This traditional Lodi Old Vine Zinfandel is deep and rich, showing ripe black fruit flavours with subtle jam and chocolate overtones, typical of these family grown vineyards. Gentle on the palate with a subtle, smoky finish.
- 616 Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve, Berton Vineyard, Coonawarra, Australia (D)**  
This award-winning Cabernet Sauvignon, shows an intense, ripe berry bouquet with hints of fresh tobacco and sweet pepper. The palate is brimming with crushed blackberry, cassis and mineral notes enhanced by subtle eucalyptus characteristic of this region and is beautifully complemented by elegant French oak notes.

## Sparkling Wine.

### 701 Domaine Carneros, Napa County, United States (2)

This Sparkling Brut is the signature wine of Domaine Carneros. It is a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay providing a tapestry of flavours including lime, honeycomb and lemon curd. The cool Carneros fruit creates wines of depth and complexity that are enhanced by a minimum of three years of bottle age sur lie in the cellar before release. This extra bottle age yields a complex, toasty aroma with fine, pinpoint bubbles.

## White Wines.

### 702 Chablis 1er Cru Vaillons, Olivier Tricon, Burgundy, France

A delicate, complex Chablis. Brilliant pale yellow with green tints. Lovely nose combining citrus fruits, acacia, candied and mineral notes, flowing into a well-structured, ripe, rounded and concentrated palate where well-integrated freshness adds depth. A Chablis with real allure.

### 703 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc, Chateau Fargueirol, Rhône, France (2)

Château Fargueirol basks in an exceptional location to the north of the town, with a stunning view of Mont Ventoux, the Rhône river and the castle of Châteauneuf du Pape. The wine possesses apricot notes with aromas of peaches, anise and sweet spices. Flavours of gingerbread and a perfectly round and oily mouthfeel.

### 704 Riesling Grand Cru, Domaines Schlumberger, Saering, Alsace, France (3)

Domaines Schlumberger own 70 hectares of Grand Cru vineyards in the southern part of Alsace, which are all organically farmed. The soil is comprised of marl, limestone and sandstone resulting in a ripe, structured, complex and elegant dry Riesling.

### 705 Montagny 1er Cru Les Coères, Albert Sounit, Burgundy, France (2)

"Les Coères" is the largest 1. Cru vineyard in Montagny. The wine has an intense nose of fresh green fruit – apple, pear – and white flowers and fennel. The wine is well structured and mineral with an appealing level of refreshing acidity on the palate. The oak influence is almost absent, just contributing with structure and freshness.

### 706 Sauvignon Blanc, St Supéry, Napa Valley, California, USA (2)

Yellow grapefruit, green lime and passionfruit aromas mingle with a subtle touch of anise. A vibrant freshness on the palate with flavours of pink grapefruit and lime zest.

### 707 Pouilly-Fumé, Château de Tracy, Comtesse A. Astutt d'Assay, Loire, France (2)

One of the finest and most historic Domaines in the Pouilly Fumé appellation and the quintessential Sauvignon Blanc. This is a stunning wine, the long contact with the lees has helped to develop both depth and complexity.

### 708 Chardonnay, Buena Vista Winery, Carneros, California, USA (2)

This Chardonnay entices you immediately with aromas of nectarine, Meyer lemon, a touch of jasmine, concentrated green apple and stone fruit, notes of honey and toasted vanilla leading to a soft, creamy and lush finish.

### 709 Chardonnay, Planeta, Sicily, Italy (2)

A rich, golden Chardonnay that bundles yellow peaches, acacia honey and a touch of marzipan into a net of fine-thread acidity, then hits you with a homely waft of toast.

### 710 Reserva Branco, Quinta dos Carvalhais, Dão, Portugal (2)

This wine is bright straw-yellow in colour and has buttery aromas from the oak ageing with hints of honey and citrus. Herbaceous and mineral notes add freshness and complexity to the wine. On the palate, there is an aromatic complexity from the time in oak barrels which also adds a polished smoothness to the fruit character. The finish is long and elegant.

## Red Wines.

**711 Chorey-les-Beaune, Domaine Maillard Père et Fils, Burgundy, France (C)**  
Toasty white Burgundy, buttery in the mouth, restrained by fine minerality and pleasantly perfumed with grilled nuts.

**712 La Grola, Allegrini, Veronese, Veneto, Italy (E)**  
This single vineyard masterpiece is the pride and joy of the Allegrini family - acclaimed sixth generation grape growers turned winemakers. Lavishly oak aged then matured in bottle before release, it delivers rare power, precision and elegance.

**713 Psi, Peter Sisseck, Ribero del Duero, Spain (D)**  
Danish born, Bordeaux-trained Peter Sisseck furrowed his future in Spain. In 1990, he arrived in the then rather unknown area of Ribera del Duero. Peter however believed that it had the potential to produce Spain's finest wines. It was from this belief that the iconic Pingus, then Flor de Pingus were created, wines which soared to worldwide acclaim. With PSI, Peter seeks to capture and protect the very essence of the Ribera del Duero.

**714 Saint-Émilion Grand Cru, Château Barrail du Blanc, Bordeaux, France (C)**  
A perennial favourite of Cunard, this is a tiny 3 hectare estate on light, sandy soil in St Sulpice de Faleyren. This Saint-Émilion Grand Cru offers a sweet, earthy ripe perfume of red fruits, a supple, generous structure, lovely density and delicate fruit to the finish.

**715 Cabernet Sauvignon, Bakestone, Napa, California, USA (D)**  
From legendary Californian producer Cakebread, comes their second label, Bakestone Cellars. A wine offering their trademark freshness, concentration and complexity from select premier vineyards around Northern California. Black berry, black cherry and blueberry notes combine with sweet spices. Balanced and supple, with finely structured tannins.

**716 Shiraz Reunion, The Lane, Adelaide Hills, Australia (D)**  
The Lane's vineyards benefit from the relative cool climate of the Adelaide Hills. The vines are kept cool when temperatures drop substantially at night, resulting in well-balanced wine with fresh acidity. Classically structured and very smooth, this wine combines concentrated dark fruits, pepper and warm spice.

**717 Zinfandel, Seghesio, Sonoma County, United States of America (E)**  
A sumptuous example of this Californian classic. Made by Zinfandel specialist the Seghesio family, whose range of Zinfandels are unsurpassed in California. Bold dark fruits, medium bodied with a lovely succulent, juicy savoury character

**718 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Grand Veneur - Alain Jaume & Fils, Rhône, France (E)**  
Produced from vineyards located in the northern part of Châteauneuf du Pape, displaying all the characteristics of the terroir. An intense dark-ruby color. The nose develops aromas of ripe black fruits, cherry and spice box. The palate reveals strong yet elegant tannins. The finish is long and luxurious.

**719 Petit Verdot 'Chaski', Viña Perez Cruz, Chile (D)**  
From one of the most unique eco-friendly wineries in the world. This complex and elegant Petit Verdot has an intense palate of vibrant black fruits mixed with mint, black pepper and dark chocolate notes. Surprisingly fresh with soft tannins and a delicious long finish.

**720 Château Beau-Site, Cru Bourgeois Supérieur, Bordeaux, France (C)**  
"Beau-Site" means beautiful site and lies just behind Grand Cru Château Calon-Segur on one of Medoc's highest points with fantastic views over the river Gironde. Notes of bilberry, spice and hints of cigar continue on the palate which is enveloped in smooth, ripe tannins. This wine shows lovely balance, depth and structure with an elegantly spiced finish.
