COMMODORE SIR JAMES CHARLES

KBE CBE RD RNR (1865 – 1928)

Knighted by: King George V

Date: 1918

With quite the reputation for doing things on a grand scale, Charles' dinner parties aboard Aquitania were well renowned as opulently social affairs, often centring around entire herds of exotic feather-gilded fare.

Ever the showman, he bowed out of service just as grandly upon the completion of his 726th transatlantic crossing – passing away in his quarters on what was to be the eve of his retirement.

COMMODORE SIR ARTHUR ROSTRON

KBE CBE RD RNR (1869 – 1940)

Knighted by: King George V

Date: 1926

Calmer than the oceans
he called home, Rostron is
perhaps the most celebrated of
all Cunard captains. His repose
lead to the safe rescue of all
survivors of Titanic, prudently
redirecting heating power
to the engines and ensuring
Carpathia's swift arrival.

His composure finally faltered
when he refused to travel to the
shipbreakers with his beloved
Mauretania, overcome with
emotion after ten years as
her master.

COMMODORE SIR EDGAR BRITTEN

KB RD RNR (1874 – 1936)

Knighted by: King George V

Date: 1934

From humble Bradford beginnings and against the will of his family, Britten escaped to sea at just aged fifteen. Steadfastly working his way up from the bottom ranks with nothing but his own perseverance as his guide.

In the years to come, that same decisiveness would see him appointed Commodore to the newly created Cunard White Star Line and first master to Queen Mary, commanding both her maiden voyage and the taking of the Blue Riband, awarded for the fastest Atlantic crossing by a commercial passenger vessel.

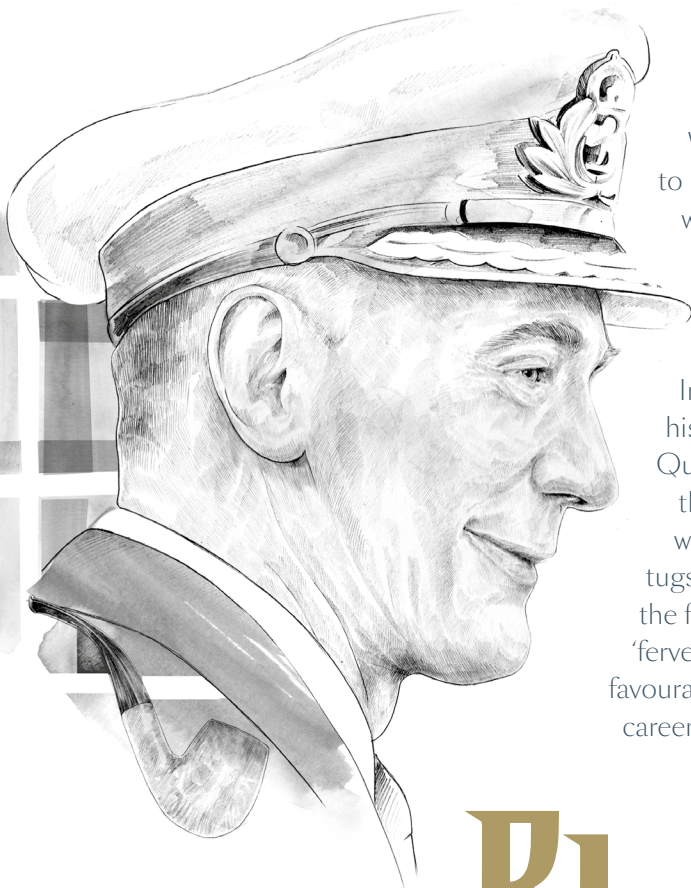


COMMODORE
SIR ROBERT IRVING

KB OBE RD RNR (1877 – 1954)

Knighted by: King George VI

Date: 1943



While other Commodores tended to be of modest origin, Robert Irving was certainly not. Heralding from a wealthy and well-connected Scottish Border family, he was chieftain of his clan.

Irving's service to the company saw his command of both Aquitania and Queen Mary. He once boldly docked the 81,235-ton Queen in New York without the usual aid of 12 powerful tugs during a strike. He accomplished the feat with only two rowboat helpers, 'fervent prayers' to St. Christopher, and favourable conditions. After an illustrious career he retired to his family seat 1944.

COMMODORE SIR JAMES BISSET

KB CBE RD RNR LLD (1883 – 1966)

Knighted by: King George VI

Date: 1945

Valuable cargo came to be something of a defining characteristic of Bisset's tenure with the company.

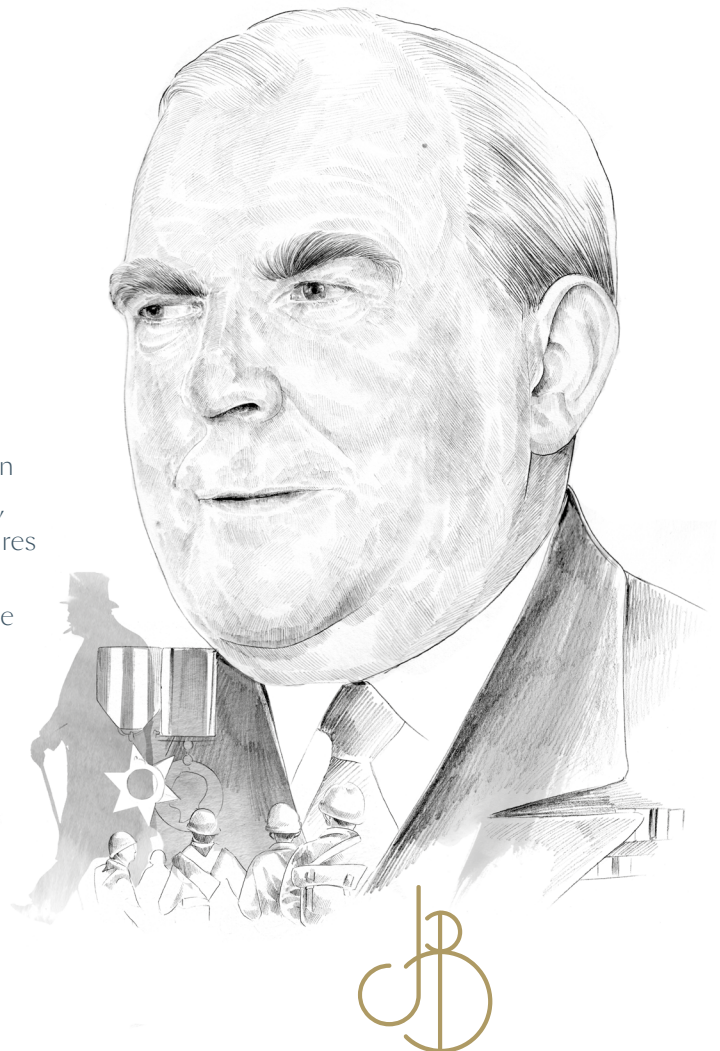
Throughout WWII he commanded both Queen Mary and Queen Elizabeth across the Atlantic, once carrying a record 16,683 American GIs and becoming a personal friend to Churchill before, during peacetime, safely delivering the Magna Carta home to Lincoln Cathedral by sleeping with it safely stowed beneath his bed.

COMMODORE
SIR CYRIL ILLINGWORTH

KB RD RNR (1883 – 1958)

Knighted by: King George VI

Date: 1949

Ever the patriot, Illingworth once said of his countrymen, “We have the great intangibles – character, experience, patience, determination. We are not called Great Britain for nothing!”

A man of both endurance and eloquence, he once weathered an exceptionally violent storm aboard the Ascania’s bridge for 75 sleepless hours. His tenacity and perseverance earned him the captaincy of Queen Mary in 1942.

Knighted by: Queen Elizabeth II

Date: 1955

Raised in the constant presence of Liverpool's industrious shipyards, it is perhaps no surprise that Thompson grew into a seafaring life in steam – nor that he became a near fanatical Liverpool Football Club supporter.

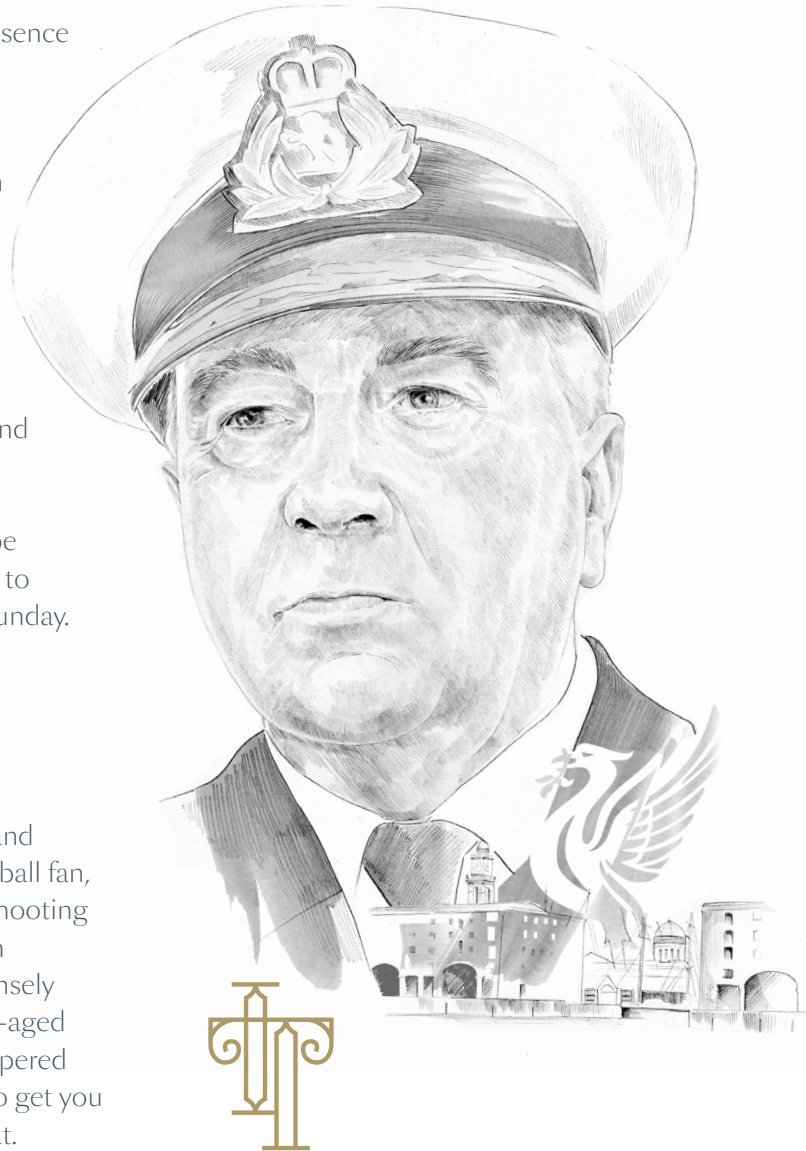

Our martinis are invariably stirred to ensure the flavour is not diluted, as per esteemed mixologists' methodology.

However, if your preference is for a shaken martini, we'll be happy to make it your way.

RATIOS

The proportion of gin or vodka and vermouth in a martini is a delicate balance. Less vermouth results in a drier martini, while more vermouth results in a wetter martini allowing the vermouth's botanicals to shine through.

Over the decades, flavour profiles have evolved to become more adventurous. Experimental ratios led the way to distinct flavours and complexities shaped by the calibre of vermouth.

When it comes to selecting a martini, there's a sophisticated combination to satisfy every refined taste.

Explore different ratios to unearth unique tastes.

"FIFTY-FIFTY"

1.5 oz of gin or vodka and 1.5 oz of vermouth.

For those who appreciate balance.

"SOPPING WET"

1 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz of gin or vodka and 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz of vermouth.

An indulgence for those seeking a positively spirited creation.

"CLASSIC WET MARTINI"

2 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz of gin or vodka and $\frac{1}{2}$ oz of vermouth

Suited for those who prefer timeless simplicity in every sip.

"MONTGOMERY"

2 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz of gin or vodka and $\frac{1}{2}$ oz of vermouth.

Not just the name of a rich man's cat, but a favourite of Ernest Hemingway.

"FRANKLIN"

2 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz gin or vodka and $\frac{1}{2}$ oz vermouth (stirred with ice,
then discarded).

Order one of these and you'll really look the part.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

“Dirty”

A polite ¼ oz dash of olive brine.

An ode to Franklin D. Roosevelt’s favourite, who even carried a sophisticated ‘martini kit’ on foreign trips.

“Filthy”

A hearty ½ oz dash of olive brine and an uneven number of olives.

Both salty, sophisticated, and superstitious, of course.

“Bradford”

Shaken with bitters and ice.

A zesty, much-loved concoction dating to the 1900s.

“Churchill”

Dry gin, stirred, with an unopened bottle of vermouth waved above the mixing glass. In other words, very dry.

GARNISHES

Whether it’s your tasting palate or superstitions that guide your choice of garnish, we have a host of accompaniments to embellish your martini, spanning lemons, olives, or onions. We recommend using an orange twist instead of lemon for red or rosé vermouths.

“Dickens”

No olives, no twist, and certainly no turns – just great expectations with every sip.

“Gibson”

Two simple yet delicious pickled pearl onions.

Legend has it that the Gibson originated from a savvy 1950s banker who discreetly sipped pickle-garnished cold water during indulgent three-martini client lunches.
